Serving on the board of a non-profit organization is an honor, and the honor comes with responsibilities. Board members are responsible and accountable for the non-profit's actions and have fiduciary duties to the organization. Board members are legally required to be informed active participants in corporate governance and to act in furtherance of the nonprofit's charitable mission. To help you and the other board members of your non-profit understand and fulfill your duties, the Ohio Attorney General's Charitable Law Section has developed a number of resources to assist you:

1. Charitable University is an online learning platform featuring resources for charitable board members. Various webinars cover topics such as board governance, financial activities, fundraising and governmental filings. Those who complete the training requirements receive a certificate and will have their names published on the web page. For additional information, go to Charitable.OhioAGO.gov/Charitable-University.
2. There is a pre-recorded webinar that contains an overview of the legal obligations of board members. This webinar can be viewed anytime and can be found at Charitable.OhioAGO.gov/Charitable-Webinars.
3. We offer a monthly one-hour live webinar on board governance that explains your fiduciary duties and how to fulfill them. This one-hour webinar is at noon on the first Wednesday of each month. Register for the webinar at Charitable.OhioAGO.gov/Charitable-Webinars.
4. The Charitable Law Section will provide live training on board governance issues throughout the state if your organization is willing to host a training and invite other charitable organizations to attend.
